## **Chathurthi (10 September 2021) - COVID 19**

As always, the safety and wellbeing of our devotees and our volunteer staff, is of the utmost importance to us at Sri Selva Vinayagar Temple.

According to the most recent Queensland Government Direction 26 issued on 24 August 2021,

- a. only a **maximum of 200 people** will be allowed inside the Temple at any time of the day.
- b. **It is mandatory for devotees entering the temple campus to register using Check In Qld App.**
- c. **It is mandatory for devotees entering the temple to wear face mask .**
- d. There is no restriction outdoors other than that you need to practice **1.5 metre social distance and wearing of a mask.**

We are expecting a large crowd for Vinayakar Chathurthi celebrations. Therefore, the management committee has decided to take bookings in order to control the number of devotees inside the temple. Please write an email to **hasq.president@gmail.com** to book in your attendance by including the following details:

1. Number of people in your group.
2. Your expected time of arrival at the Temple
3. Your expected time of departure from the Temple.
4. Please include your mobile number for contact.

We need your mobile number in case we wish to contact you. We may have to limit the time span inside the temple for all devotees. **You will not be allowed inside the Temple campus if you have not received an email from the HASQ President confirming your booking.**

**As devotees, visitors and clients of Sri Selva Vinayakar Temple, we kindly request that you avoid visiting the Temple or the Kitchen if:**

- You exhibit signs of acute respiratory illness such as coughing, fever and shortness of breath.
- You have had recent travel (within the last 4 weeks) to any locations that are on the list of places in Australia or Countries with COVID-19 related travel restrictions by the Australian Government.
- You have had close contact with an individual diagnosed with COVID-19 related illness.
