Significance of Sivarathri

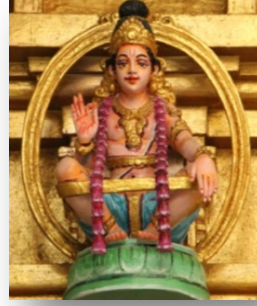
Festival of Mahasivarathri is the most important festival for the millions of devotees of Lord Shiva. The festival has been accorded lot of significance in Hindu mythology. It says that a devotee who performs sincere worship of Lord Shiva on the auspicious day of Sivarathri is absolved of sins and attains moksham.

Mahasivrathri Festival is also considered to be an extremely significant festival by women. Married and unmarried women observe fast and perform Shiva Puja with sincerity to appease Goddess Parvati who is also regarded as 'Gaura' - one who bestows marital bliss and long and prosperous married life. Unmarried women also pray for a husband like Lord Shiva who is regarded as the ideal husband.

Nei (Ghee) Abishekam will be performed after morning Puja 10:30am. monthly Maasa Abishekams are available for sponsor by devotees. Chaturthi (Sukla patksha) which comes after New moon day called Chaturthi or Monthly Chaturthi.

Ganesha Mantra

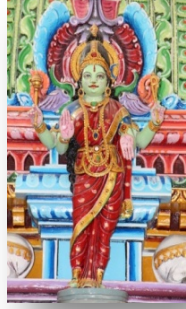
*"Vakratunda Mahaakaaya Suryakoti Samaprabhaa

Lalitha Sahasranamam (1000 names of Goddess Lalithambikai Devi) is a secret and very sacred text or mantra in Hindu religion. This mantra has been revealed to mankind through the discussion between lord Hayagriva and the great sage Agasthya.

At Selvavinayakar Kovil every third Sunday of the month Lalitha Sahastra Nama parayanam being recited with special Poojai to Goddess Lalithambikai.

Significance of Masi Makam

Masi Makam specially for Lord Shiva and Shakthi worship in Hindu religion.

Masi Makam, is an important annual festival observed by Tamilians around the world. The ritual falls in the Tamil Month of Masi (February – March). Makam, is one among the twenty seven stars in the Hindu astrological system. The Makam, star falls on a full moon day in the month of Masi and is considered highly auspicious in the Tamil speaking world and in several parts of South India.
