Aadi Pooram and Naga Chaturthi Festival on Monday 1 August 2022



Aadi Pooram is celebrated in all Hindu temples in Southern India in the month called Aadi corresponding to the English months of July-August, when the asterism Pooram (Selta Leonis) is in the ascendancy. Aadi month is also dedicated to Goddess Shakti, as the energy of the Goddess is very strong and vibrant during this month. It is believed that Goddess Parvati herself descends to the earth on this auspicious day to bless her devotees. In the Saiva temples, the day of Aadi Pooram is observed as the festival of 'Valaikappu'. In the event, glass bangles are offered to Goddess Ambal and then distributed among all devotees. It is believed that by wearing these bangles, the couples will be blessed with offspring and also when pregnant women wear these bangles; it shields their child from all the evil forces.

Devotees who wish to carry milk pots are required to be present at the temple at 7:30am. Devotees can bring bangles to offer to Goddess Abirami for the Ruthu Shanthi function.

Saiva Thirumuraikal is a division of holy hymns for Hinduism composed total of 12 Thirumuraikal-compendium.

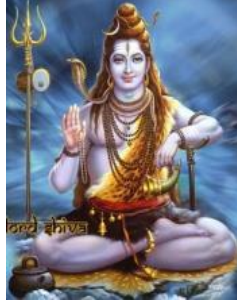
At Sri Selvavinayakar Temple Special Pooja will be performed to Saiva Saint Sundarar at 7:00pm on 05 August 2022.

Pirathosha Viratham on 10 & 24 August 2022



Prathosha Viratham is one of the most important viratha among the Virathas performed to Lord Shiva. Pirathosha Viratham comes twice a month (Lunar). Shukla Paksha and Krishna Paksha the evening of the Thirayodasi (13th moon day) between 4:30-6:00pm. Devotees worship Lord Shiva at this significant time. If the Pirathosham happened on Saturdays called Sani Pirathosham.”

Special Puja/Abishekam will be performed to Sri Ayyappa Swamy on the first five days of every Hindu calendar month. These poojas usually named after each Zodiac (Rasi) signs. This month puja called "Idapa" Masa Abishekam".

Lord Krishna was born on the “Rohini” nakshatram (star) on Ashtami day. The festival Sri Krishna Jayanthi is also known as Gokulashtami and Janmashtami. Krishna is Lord Vishnu’s eighth avatar (incarnation) on Earth. He is the Lord’s most glorious incarnation.

Vinayakar Chaturthy Viratham and Maha Homam on 31 August 2022



Vinayaga Chaturthi is an auspicious Hindu festival which is celebrated for 10 days every year. At Sri Selva Vinayagar Temple, there will be 15 days special pooja for Lord Ganesha from 17/8/2022 to 30/8/2022. Though it is celebrated every month, Avani Vinayaga Chaturthi is specially celebrated for the birthday of Vinayaga. He is the God of wealth, sciences, knowledge, wisdom and prosperity, and most Hindus seek his blessings before starting any important work. It is believed that devotees who pray to Lord Ganesha can fulfil their wishes and desires. So, the main essence of Ganesh Chaturthi is that devotees who pray to him are set free of sins, and it leads them on the path of knowledge and wisdom.
