New entry conditions during Stage 3 of the COVID-19 Pandemic

The Queensland Government has announced a staged relaxation of the COVID-19 restrictions and as such, from 12 noon on July 3rd 2020 a gathering of a maximum 100 persons at a time is allowed at places of worship. We are thrilled to announce that we are able to open the temple to devotees without prior bookings from midday July 3rd 2020.

Please be aware that to manage the 100 person limit, devotees are required to register their name and mobile number at the entrance in the book provided. This is important to enable contact tracing in the event of new COVID-19 infection cases or clusters. Please note that if the number of patrons inside the temple is strictly limited to 100 and all remaining patrons will be required to wait outside until access can be granted.

This restriction has to be strictly followed due to the government guidelines that only 100 persons can gather at a any particular time. It is imperative that patrons do not have symptoms of COVID-19, have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 or have not been in contact with any patients with COVID-19.

Once inside the temple premises, please ensure that you strictly follow the existing current COVID-19 guidelines (i.e. one person per 4 square metre rule and social distancing of 1.5mtrs).

Due to the temple returning to its new normal activities, we are unable to continue to livestream the Vasantha Mandapa pooja via Facebook. The final livestream will occur on Friday evening on July 3rd 2020.

Please note that the canteen has started its operation on Saturdays and on Sundays from 9.30AM to 1PM. It is important to follow the COVID-19 guidelines in the canteen area as well.
